What is Scrum?



An agile project management method that offers an iterative and collaborative approach.



A framework designed to help teams create valuable products by emphasizing collaboration and regular interaction among all stakeholders.

Scrum ceremonies



All the meetings (planning poker, sprint planning, stand-ups, daily meetings...) that structure the project to ensure optimal coordination and productivity.

Scrum Terminology

Backlog

A list that prioritizes the product features to be improved or developed.

Story point

A unit of measure used to estimate the effort required to complete a task.

Sprint

A 2- to 4-week period during which the team focuses on development.

User story

A simple description of a user need.

The Fundamentals of Scrum



Transparency
with the entire team for a clear and shared vision



Regular Inspection
essential for adjusting work when needed



Adaptation
to changes to realign product development

The Different Roles



Scrum Master
Facilitates Scrum and smooths team interactions.



Product Owner
Product vision's guardian and connects client with team.



Dev team
Transforms customer needs into usable features.

How to implement Scrum ?



Train teams to evolve the mindset.



Equip teams to streamline the workflow.
